Mr. Arpan Sabharwal, Advocate appears on behalf of respondents no.3 & 4, who are stated to be present in Court today. Power of attorney filed in Court today is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

This civil writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent no.2 on an application filed by respondents no.3 & 4 under Section 22 of Maintenance & Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007. The petitioners have been ordered to vacate house No.40, New Lasuri Mohalla, Basti Danishmanda, Jalandhar and to hand over vacant possession of the same to respondents no.3 & 4.

Notice of motion had been issued to the respondents as it was stated that the petitioners restrict their prayer to the grant of some reasonable time to vacate the premises in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that he does not press this petition on merits, however, the petitioners may be permitted to retain possession of the premises in question till 01.03.2020 to make arrangements for alternate accommodation. The petitioners, it is submitted, undertake to vacate the premises by 01.03.2020 and hand over vacant, peaceful possession of the premises in question to respondents no.3 & 4.

Learned counsel for respondents no.3 & 4, on instructions from respondents no.3 & 4, submits that the said respondents have no objection, in case the petitioners retain possession of the premises in question till 01.03.2020, provided they undertake to hand over vacant, peaceful possession of the same on expiry of the said period.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and specifically the stand of the parties, this petition is dismissed as not pressed. The petitioners are, however, permitted to retain possession of the premises in question till 01.03.2020. They shall hand over vacant, peaceful possession of the premises in question to respondents no.3 & 4 on or before 01.03.2020. It is made clear that in case, needful is not done by the petitioners, respondents no.3 & 4 are entitled to take possession of the premises forthwith, with police help and without any further reference.
