Defendant-petitioner has filed the present revision petition against the order passed by learned Rent Controller refusing to strike off certain paragraphs in the affidavit of Razia and Robinson tendered in examination-in-chief.

Learned Court has already observed that the fact whether such evidence is beyond pleading or not, shall be decided at the stage of final arguments of the case. The aforesaid witnesses are yet to be cross-examined. Defendant-petitioner is defending an ejectment petition filed by the landlord seeking his eviction alongwith other respondents.

In the considered view of this Court, learned Rent Controller was correct in disposing of the application with the observation that the aforesaid aspect shall be considered at the stage of

final decision of the case.
