Petitioner has filed this petition for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 23.10.2019 in case FIR No.283 dated 15.05.2019, under Sections 182, 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station, Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 23.10.2019 when the concession of pre-arrest bail was extended to respondent No.2, the factum of compromise between the parties was pleaded by the accused. It is argued that the said compromise has been violated by the accused and, therefore, the concession of pre-arrest bail deserves to be withdrawn. However, it is not disputed that the accused has not misused the bail so far in any manner.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

A perusal of the order dated 23.10.2019 reveals that the factum

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of compromise was one of the arguments raised by the learned counsel on behalf of the accused. However, while granting the concession, no weightage was attached to the said compromise and no such condition in case of violation was imposed. At the same time, the stand of the State was noticed, whereby it was apprised that respondent No.2 had joined the investigation, who was not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for cancellation of bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
