Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has moved a complaint dated 12.05.2019 with the Station House Officer, Police Station Gharaunda, Haryana alleging cheating and fraud of Rs.38,080/- and breach of trust at the hands of officials of Sahara Credit Co-operative Society Limited, Village Barsat. He has submitted that when no action was taken, he served the legal notices dated 13.06.2019 and 05.08.2019 (Annexures P2 and P-3 respectively) before approaching this Court.

Petitioner has an alternate remedy by invoking Section 156(3) of Code of Criminal Procedure. However, he has not done so. The jurisdiction of the High Court under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure cannot be invoked in routine to direct the police to register the FIR.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to invoke the remedy available to him under the Code of Criminal Procedure.
