Petitioners/defendants have preferred this revision petition against the order dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Divion) Guruharsahai, vide which, evidence of the petitioners/defendants was closed by order of the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners/defendants has submitted that the petitioners/defendants have availed five opportunities of effective hearing to enable them to complete their evidence but on account of filing of miscellaneous application by the respondent/plaintiff, the trial was put off the track leading to filing of the present revision.

Heard.

In the light of the sole averment made by the counsel for the petitioners/defendants that reasonable opportunity may be afforded to the petitioners/defendants to complete their evidence, as a short point is involved, which necessitates disposal of the present revision without issuing notice to the opposite side as no order prejudicial to the interest of parties is being passed.

It is well settled principle of law that the parties should not be prejudiced by such an approach and reasonable opportunity be afforded to the petitioners/defendants to complete their evidence, therefore, it would be suffice to hold that they be afforded one opportunity only of effective hearing to complete their evidence as per the list of witnesses furnished before the trial Court subject to payment of costs of Rs.1,000/-, which shall go to the plaintiff/respondent.

Payment of costs shall be the condition precedent for granting indulgence in favour of the petitioners/defendants in the aforesaid context.

Disposed off in those terms.
