The matter having been referred to mediation on the last date of hearing, the report of the learned Mediator is on record, stating to the effect that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the respondent, with the settlement/compromise deed dated February 03, 2020 having also been annexed with the report.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact, the second appeal filed by the petitioner, i.e. RSA no.2386 of 2018, has also been dismissed by a coordinate Bench, vide an order passed on January 28, 2020 and this petition in fact is one challenging an order passed by the executing court, dismissing the objections filed by the petitioner.

Keeping all the aforesaid circumstances in mind, obviously this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such, with the parties however held bound to the terms of the compromise as settled

between them before the learned Mediator, in terms of the compromise deed
dated February 03, 2020.
