[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that appeal filed by the petitioner against refusal by the Inquiry Officer to permit engaging of counsel to represent the petitioner in the proceedings before the Inquiry Officer has not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner and that the writ petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to decide the appeal within such time as is granted by this Court.

[3] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the appeal, Annexure P/7 dated 23.12.2019 as expeditiously as possible and not later than four weeks from today and to communicate the

decision to the petitioner. In the meantime, enquiry proceedings be deferred to await the outcome of the decision on the appeal, Annexure P/7 dated 23.12.2019.
