Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.688 dated 24.08.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506, 427, 354 and 307 IPC at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR in question was registered against more than 60 persons including the present petitioners. A bare perusal of the FIR clearly reveals that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present FIR and they have nothing to do with the alleged occurrence. It has also been submitted that Final Report under Section 173 Cr.PC against the petitioners has been presented and the petitioners are behind bars since 10.09.2019. Hence, no useful purpose would be served by

keeping the petitioners in judicial custody as the appeal is unlikely to conclude in the near future.

Learned State counsel while filing the reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nuh, has opposed the grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioners. As per the affidavit, four FIRs have been registered against the present petitioners for the alleged occurrence. In support thereof, the photographs of CCTV footage has also been annexed as Annexure R-1.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the evidence available on record.

A perusal of the FIR reveals that there are serious allegations against the petitioners for having ransacked different places including a hospital, leading to a serious law and order problem in the city.

In view of the above, I do not find any ground to grant regular bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed. However, it is made clear that nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as an opinion on the merit of the case.
