Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 86 dated 26.12.2019 registered under Sections 353, 186, 148 and 506 IPC at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the occurrence took place at the spur of midnight, when the petitioner No. 2 took her mother alongwith petitioner No.1 to Civil Hospital, Bhol Kalota, but the same was not intentional.

On instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, learned State counsel states that petitioners have ill-treated the Doctor and the present FIR has registered.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

It is ordered that the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
