This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 107 dated 09.05.2019, registered under Sections 302 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mohindergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the FIR, only co-accused Rajbir was named, whereas the name of the petitioner surfaced on the disclosure of co-accused Rajbir.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, aforesaid co-accused Rajbir was seen going behind deceased Tara Chand (brother of the complainant) and the only evidence of 'last seen' is against co-accused Rajbir, who has already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 16.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-52718-2019.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Kuldeep, however, submits that the prosecution evidence has almost been concluded

and the trial is likely to complete soon.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that main accused Rajbir has already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court as noticed above, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
