Learned counsel for the petitioner states that all the retiral benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for have not been released to him. As per the petitioner, the retiral benefits, which have been released to the petitioner are short by ₹1,52,466/-.

Further prayer of the petitioner is that 20% amount, which has been deducted from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner as a tax deducted at source, is also illegal and therefore, the said amount be refunded to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has served a legal notice dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-11) upon the respondent, which is still pending consideration with the respondent and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order, in accordance with law.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondent is directed to decide the legal notice dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-11), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
