Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No.NACT 90/2019 titled 'M/s Phagwara Home Appliances vs. Ramandeep Kaur' under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

On 10.01.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Bailable warrants issued to the petitioner were not received back and thereafter, the Court proceeded to issue non-bailable warrants.

Notice of motion for 03.03.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara either on the date fixed or prior thereto and in the event of her appearance, she shall be granted interim bail on her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara.”

Learned counsel for the complainant submitted that the complainant has received the principal amount forming subject matter of cheque in dispute.

It is not in dispute that in compliance of the order dated 10.01.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara.

In view of aforesaid, interim order dated 10.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on appearing regularly before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara.

Petition stands disposed of.
