**Prayer in CRM-19058 of 2020 is for withdrawal of the present
petition on the basis of compromise.**

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the light of the order passed in Criminal Misc. M No.19291 of 2020 (Ruchi Bhalla and others Vs. State of Punjab and others), whereby FIR No.120, dated 16.11.2019, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom has been quashed on the basis of compromise, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be permitted to be withdrawn.

In the light of the above statement of counsel for the petitioners, the prayer is accepted, CRM-19058-2020 is allowed and the petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.
