After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the higher authorities of the department raising grievance against the order passed by the Director declining the claim of the petitioner for consideration of the service, which the petitioner had rendered in the earlier Public Sector Undertakings, which is followed by the Government service as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits on the ground that said service cannot be taken into consideration as the petitioner had resigned from those PSUs.

Learned counsel prays that direction be issued to the respondents that in case any representation is filed before the higher authorities, the same be disposed of expeditiously.

No order is required on this prayer of the petitioner as it is expected that all the authorities work according to law and decide the claims within the time frame it requires.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty, as prayed for.
