Vide order dated 08.01.2020, Warrant Officer was appointed to visit the place of detention of detenues as shown in para No.4 of the petitioner.

In compliance of the aforesaid order, report dated 10.01.2020 has been submitted by the Warrant Officer. The extracted portion of the report reads as under:-

“In compliance to the orders of the Hon'ble Court dt. 08.01.2020, it is fairly submitted that undersigned alongwith petitioner and police party of the Police Station Shahzadpur Distt. Ambala reached at Aggarwal Brick Kiln situated in the area of the village Baragarh and 30 laborers including men, women and children freed and after recording their statement, custody given to the petitioner

alongwith their belongings who left the Brick Kiln in a canter bearing number UP 12 AT 4326 (Flat 'Y'), which was arranged by the petitioner himself. Respondent No.5, Manish the partner of the Brick Kiln not objected the release of the labour who was available in the Police Station at the time of release of labourers. On the asking of the petitioner visit closed and Undersigned return to the Chandigarh.

Accordingly report is submitted for kind perusal before the Hon'ble Court.”

In view of aforesaid report submitted by the Warrant Officer, no further action is called for. This petition stands disposed of. However, the detenues would be at liberty to take recourse to their legal remedies in accordance with law.
