The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 96, dated 04.07.2019, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar, Nakodar.

Reliance has been placed on record in CRM-M-12048-2018 and CRM-M-27689-2018 wherein the benefit of bail was granted with regard to the recovery of 270 grams of heroine on the score that the recovery was marginal higher than the commercial quantity.

In the instant case, 262 grams of heroine has been recovered from the petitioner who is a lady. Her arrest was effected on 04.07.2019 and the custody certificate has been placed on record which indicates that she is in custody for a period of last more than six months. The custodial interrogation of the petitioner is over and she has been remanded to judicial custody. The conclusion of trial is likely to take sometime. The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case of NDPS Act.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant

furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
