Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 08.01.2020 in this regard to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, State of Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record only the copies of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age.

During the course of hearing, the petitioner No.1 has also produced self attested copies of her Matriculation certificate and Birth Certificate, which are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place. Four photographs on two sheets as Annexure P-3 and a copy of certificate as Annexure P-4 regarding performance of marriage, have also been placed on record.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 08.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
