Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 03.01.2020, in this regard, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, Gurdaspur.

Heard. Record perused.

Petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and photographs (Anneuxre P-4).

During the course of hearing, the petitioners have also made available copy of Matriculation Certificate and Senior Secondary School Examination Certificate of petitioner No.1 and 2 respectively, which are taken on record and be tagged at appropriate place.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the

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Superintendent of Police, Batala, to look into the representation Annexure

P-5 dated 03.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
