In the instant case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2019 registered at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar.

Heard.

Precisely, the allegations against the petitioner are to the effect that he has embezzled a sum of Rs.24,335/- by showing the payment of wages to the labourers and further a sum of Rs.10,000/- having been embezzled by forging the signatures of Panch Shri Parvez.

It has not been disputed that the amount of Rs.24,335/- has already been deposited. On the similar allegations, the petitioner was suspended and his appeal was dismissed vide order dated 09.04.2019 (Annexure P-3). The said order has also been challenged by the petitioner by filing a separate petition and the effect of said order has been stayed.

The arrest of the petitioner was effected on 28.12.2019. His custodial interrogation is over and he has been remanded to judicial custody. The case hinges on the documentary evidence.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars in the present case. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
