The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conclude the investigation into the complaint dated 27.2.2019, registered with UID No.1518661 on 12.3.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although he had submitted a complaint dated 27.2.2019 to the police followed by representations dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-6) and representation dated 3.1.2020 (Annexure P-7) but till date the matter has not been inquired into by the police.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the allegations made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.3) to ensure that in case complaint dated 27.2.2019 is still pending the same be disposed of expeditiously in accordance with law.

In the meantime, the petitioner, in any case, would be at liberty to have recourse to other appropriate alternate efficacious remedies as may be available to him including moving an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.

A copy of this order be sent to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.3), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
