In the instant case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.213 dated 21.10.2019 under Sections 379 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station West Sector 11 Chandigarh, District Chandigarh.

Briefly, as per the allegations in the FIR, Adarsh Kumar Singla (complainant) had gone to New OPD of PGI Chandigarh on 14.10.2019 and at about 11:00 am he had gone inside the lift and came out on the third floor. Taking advantage of the crowd, some unknown person had stolen his gold *kara* from his right arm. Accordingly, the case was registered.

It has been stated that after two days, the petitioner was arrested in another case while snatching a chain and made a confession with regard to involvement in the present case. The recovery of *kara* has also been effected from her.

It has not been disputed that the investigation of the case is complete; the petitioner has not been named in the FIR; there is no allegation with regard to use of any force at the time of commission of theft; challan has already been presented and the offences are triable by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars in the present case. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
