Payment of ₹10 lakhs through demand drafts dated 24.02.2020, copies of which have been placed on file, has been made to learned counsel for the respondent, who has accepted the same and submits that he will withdraw the application under Section 33-C (2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, pending before the Labour Court-I, Faridabad. He submits that as per order dated 08.09.2017, respondent will avail other legal remedies available to him regarding the payment of provident fund and other dues.

In view of submission of learned counsel for the respondent, respondent will make a statement before the Labour Court concerned seeking withdrawal of application under Section 33-C (2) of Industrial

Disputes Act So far as the right of the respondent to claim his other dues is concerned, he may avail other legal remedies available to him subject to order dated 08.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of submission of learned counsel for the respondent, the matter has been rendered infructuous.
