Petitioner has filed this first petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 78 dated 24.03.2017 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and Section 120-B IPC added lateron, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Insurance Company issued insurance policy on 27th July 2015 in favour of Balbir Singh, who passed away earlier i.e. 05th July 2015. The petitioner is in custody since 20th November 2019. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and no other case is pending against the petitioner. He further states that main beneficiary Sunita and Wazir Singh have been granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh

has not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 20th November 2019

and the recovery whatsoever has been effected.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Vikarm is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
