RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

While convicting the petitioner, Judicial Magistrate First Class sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 1 year and to pay a fine of Rs.2000/- under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. The amount of fine was paid. The award of compensation to the tune of Rs.50,000/- was made in favour of the complainant. Petitioner was directed to deposit the amount of compensation after expiry of period of appeal/revision.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already undergone requisite period of sentence and this criminal revision has become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

For realisation of the amount of compensation, the complainant may resort to his legal remedy.
