Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.215 dated 26.07.2018 registered under Sections 304-B, 34 of IPC at Police Station Kheri Pul, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that it being an inter-religion marriage, was a dowry-less marriage. Petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2018.

However, at this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijender, states that as against the total 16 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 11 witnesses have already been examined and the remaining witnesses are formal witnesses.

Considering the fact that petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2018 and only formal witnesses are left out, the present petition seeking regular bail is hereby dismissed, however, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to expedite the trial.
