The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.113, dated 31.03.2019, registered under Sections 379-A, 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Line Jind, District Jind, Haryana.

2. The Petitioner was arrested on 13th August, 2019, after which he has remained in detention.

3. Challan submitted after completion of investigation.

4. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner that the co-accused, namely, Pramjeet has already been granted bail.

5. Admittedly, the Petitioner was not named in the FIR and there is no available material to show that he was at any time identified by the complainant being the actual culprit.

6. His prayer for bail was nevertheless rejected by the Ld. Court below on the ground that he is reported to be involved in two other cases of similar nature being FIR No.690 dated 24.12.2018 and FIR No.628 dated 11.11.2018. But, as it transpires, he is already on bail in those cases.

7. In such circumstances, further detention of the present Petitioner, at this stage, for an indefinite period is not justifiable. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
