Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 20.09.2019, registered under Sections 324, 232, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dhariwal District Gurdaspur.

Petitioner is an author of injury No.1 on the person of Jagir Masih. The injury is found to be incised wound measuring 3 x 1 cm of posterior surface of superior part of right ear pinna.

The aforesaid injury has been declared to be grievous in nature, attracting culpability in terms of Section 326 IPC. The FIR in question also contains allegations of house trespass.

Recovery of the weapon is to be effected.

In view of above, no ground is made out to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.
