This is a petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.372 dated 27.12.2019 under Sections 186, 332, 353, 379B IPC, 1860 (Section 34 IPC added later on in impugned order) registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is 64 years of lady and have no role to play in the present case. There was a family dispute and with her intervention that the matter was settled and the police called by her daughter-in-law Pinky.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar states that mobile phone is yet to be recovered from Sandeep son of the petitioner.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if she is sought to be arrested, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction

of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
