This is second petition for grant of bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.17 dated 21.1.2019 registered under Sections 15, 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

First petition was dismissed on 15.11.2010.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner had undergone surgery for treating Hernia on 28.11.2018 and health of the petitioner is deteriorating.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of short affidavit of Sh. Paramjit Singh Sidhu, Superintendent, Sub Jail, Moga alongwith report of the Medical Officer in which it has been reported that in ultrasound of the abdomen of the petitioner, multiple stones in the gall bladder were found and surgery has been advised. It is reported that he is stable with medicines and there are no serious symptoms which demand immediate surgery.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant bail is made out. However, Superintendent, Sub Jail, Moga is directed to get an appointment for surgery, if it is required.
