2. Background of the facts noted in the case that notice was issued on 14.01.2019. Admittedly at one stage, it was within the knowledge of the authorities that the present residence of the petitioner was changed, whereas the proclamation was again effected at the old address, i.e., 298, Mohalla, Adarsh Nagar, Division No.2, Jalandhar.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in any event, his client is willing to surrender before the trial Court forthwith.

4. In view of the circumstances narrated above, the impugned order of the trial Court is set aside and the petitioner is granted permission to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and seeks bail in accordance with law.
