Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to initiate proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. and appoint some receiver under Section 146(2) Cr.P.C. over the land in dispute by taking decision upon complaints/ representations dated 16.12.2019 (Annexure-P/4) and 20.12.2019 (Annexure P/6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has already made representation dated 16.12.2019 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib and representation dated 20.12.2019 to respondent No.3-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Fatehgrah Sahib, copies of which are available on the file as Annexure P-4 and Annexure P/6, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 only. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib and respondent No.3-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib, to look into and decide the representations dated 16.12.2019 and 20.12.2019 (Annexure P/4 and Annexure P/6 respectively) as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
