Prayer in this criminal writ petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners and to decide the representation dated 09.01.2020 (Annexure P5).

As per the statement of Monika, Senior Assistant deputed in Criminal Branch of this Court, the original file is not traceable and the Registry is trying to locate the same.

Till the time, the original file is located, it is directed that the Registry will provide a copy of the criminal writ petition from the website of this Court which will be treated as the original CRWP No.310 of 2020.

Since the parties are present in the Court in pursuance to the order dated 10.01.2020 (photocopy of the petition is taken from the website of the Court), petitioner No.1 – Ramanjeet Kaur was sent to the

Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for her counseling and recording her statement.

The Mediator has recorded her statement in which she has stated that she want to go with petitioner No.2 – Harmandeep Singh as she is married to him. She has further stated that she do not want to go with her parents and recorded her statement at her own free will, which is explained to her.

The petitioner No.1 – Ramanjeet Kaur, is set free to accompany petitioner No.2 from the Court premises itself.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala – respondent No.2 is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioners regarding threat perception to their lives and liberty and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of.
