The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail in case FIR No.197, dated 14.11.2019, registered under Sections 380, 457 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

2. Seen Reply filed on behalf of the State.
3. Recovery of the stolen Cattle has already been effected and bulk of the same was from the custody of the co-accused persons, namely Sammudin @ Sammu Mohammad and Billu.
4. Custodial interrogation of the Petitioner, in the given circumstances, is not needed. As such, in the event of arrest, the

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (Challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.. Thereafter, the Petitioner will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.
