Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was falsely implicated in case bearing FIR No.66 dated 15.05.2017 registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City Batala and he was acquitted by the Special Court on 29.03.2019. There is no other case pending against the petitioner, but the police of Police Post Chowki Nangal, District Pathankot is unnecessarily harassing him.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, the petitioner has moved a joint representation with separate copies to DGP, Punjab, Chandigarh, SSP, Pathankot, SHO, PS Taragarh,

District Pathankot and Chowki Incharge, Chowki Nangal, District Pathankot, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

This petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to look into the allegations of the petitioner and if his innocence is established, then take corrective measures in accordance with law. However, he will not be influenced by any statement of fact recorded hereinabove. He would be at liberty to devise his own ways and means to evaluate the innocence of the petitioner in accordance with law.
