[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the official respondents to regularize the appointment of the Contractual Shift Attendants in view of Notification (Annexure P-1) dated 18.06.2015.

[2] Learned counsel frankly concedes that the Policy (Annexure P-1) dated 18.06.2015, providing for regularization of service of employees was struck down by a Division Bench of this Court and that Hon'ble the Supreme Court is currently seized of the issue in Special Leave Petition (Civil) No.33265 of 2018, in case titled as '*State of Haryana and others* versus *Yogesh Tyagi and another*'.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, claim of the petitioners for regularization under a policy, which has been struck down cannot be ordered to be considered. Accordingly, in the circumstances, the writ petition is ***dismissed*** on the aforementioned ground, while leaving it open to the petitioners to seek such relief, as is permissible in the eyes of law in the event of the policy relied upon being revived in future.
