On 16.01.2020, the following order was passed:

“This is the second petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 79 dated 13.07.2019, under Sections 420, 406 of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Mehtiana, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The first petition bearing CRM-M-31790-2019 was dismissed as withdrawn on 29.10.2019 as the petitioner, on an earlier occasion, had offered to hand over a demand draft of Rs. 3 Lakh to the complainant, however, later on, the petitioner, having failed to do so, withdrew the first petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to hand over a demand draft of Rs. 3 Lakh to the complainant.

List again on 22.01.2020.

Let a demand draft of Rs. 3 Lakh, favouring the complainant, be brought on the next date of hearing.”

Today, no demand draft is produced in compliance with the

aforesaid order, rather, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks further adjournment.

It seems that the petitioner is just trying to extract more and more time by way of filing repeated petitions.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
