Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.15 dated 17.01.2019, registered at Police Station Sector 5 Gurugram, District Gurugram, under Sections 302, 201, 34 and 120-B IPC.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that star witnesses of the prosecution i.e. PW 3 Rajpal (brother-in-law of petitioner) and PW 4 Sanjay Rathi (son of sister-in-law of petitioner) have resiled from their statements and not supported the prosecution case.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ashok Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid factual position. He further states that out of 34 prosecution witnesses, only 03 witnesses have been examined.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The star prosecution witnesses have not supported the

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custody since 15.04.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
