JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a criminal writ, seeking directions to respondent No.4 to grant parole to the petitioner for six weeks to enable him to meet his old parents.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner along with his brother is in custody since 12.05.2010. The brother of the petitioner had died in custody on account of Tuberculosis. The parole has been sought on the ground of medical treatment of the parents of the petitioner.

On the other hand in the reply filed by the State, it is mentioned that there will be danger to life and family of the complainant party, if the parole is allowed to convict Karamjit Singh Kamma. It is further contended that the petitioner has been convicted in four criminal cases and there is danger to security of the State.

Heard.

In view of the antecedents of the petitioner as reflected in Annexure R-1 coupled with the apprehension expressed by the State that the release of the petitioner is likely to endanger the security of the State of maintenance of public order, no case for grant of parole is made out, at this stage.

Dismissed.
