The challenge is to the order passed by learned trial Court allowing an application filed by defendants No. 1 and 3 to set aside ex parte judgment and decree dated 27.08.2011.

Learned Court has found that defendants No. 1 and 3 were residing overseas. Thus, the Court has held that since there was no personal service of notice on defendants, hence, ex parte judgment and decree is required to be set aside.

Learned Court has recorded in an elaborate order containing cogent reasons, which do not require any interference in revisional jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the abovesaid judgment.
