By this order, FAO Nos.997 and 1010 of 2020 shall stand
disposed of.

Application for permission to lead additional evidence in order
to produce driving licence is allowed.

Learned counsel appearing for the Insurance Company was
requested to verify with regard to genuineness of the driving licence.

Learned counsel has submitted after taking instructions from
the Insurance Company that the driving licence sought to be produced in
the additional evidence, has been verified and found genuine.

In these appeals, only dispute is with regard to recovery rights awarded in favour of the Insurance Company against owner-Kunj Lal (respondent no.2). The vehicle was insured and driving licence of the driver of the vehicle has been found genuine. Accordingly, the award passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Hoshiarpur, dated 16.10.2019 with respect to grant of recovery right to the Insurance company against the appellant-Kunj Lal is set aside.

Both the appeals are allowed.
