GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Jagjit Singh has filed the present writ petition, *inter alia*, with a prayer to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service as Home Guard Volunteer under Belt No.3007 with continuity of service along with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner orally submits that the petitioner was initially appointed in the year 1992 as Home Guard Volunteer. He was under constrained circumstances and therefore could not continue his job as at that time he had fear of terrorism and also that his father was killed by the terrorist. He thereafter submitted his representation for allowing him to join back his duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been conveyed any decision of the termination of his services or any other order and therefore, he has been repeatedly making the requests for allowing him to join back his services. He further submits that in this regard the petitioner has also got served legal notice dated 06.11.2019 (Annexure P-7) which has not been decided by the Authority till date.

Without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with the directions to respondent No.3-Director General of Police (Home Guards), to consider and decide the demand stated in legal notice of the petitioner within the period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
