The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.208, dated 24.08.2017, registered under Sections 302, 379, 396, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention since 26.09.2017. Admittedly he was not named in the original FIR and the material emerging against him is identical to that of co-accused, namely, Lovepreet Singh, who had already been granted bail by this Court in **CRM-M No.24510 of 2018.**

3. Considering the overall circumstances, further detention, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Shamsher Singh @ Shera, is ordered

to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
