Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 13.01.2020, in this regard, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv sharma, Addl. P.P., UT, Chandigarh, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy supplied.

Petitioner No.1 has placed on record copies of her Secondary

School Certificate and Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record copies of Matriculation Certificate and Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) as proof of their age as well as copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and two photographs (Annexure P-4) on one sheet regarding performance of marriage.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 13.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
