Grievance of the petitioners is that although as per Punjab Educational Service (School and Inspection Border Area) Group-B Service Rules-2018 recruitment to the post of Headmaster is to be made 50% by way of direct recruitment and 50% by way of promotion yet advertisement Annexure P-1 dated 08.03.2019 was issued for all the posts of headmasters and headmistress by direct recruitment.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioners have submitted representation Annexure P-3 dated 07.11.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-3 dated 07.11.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

4. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice, waives service and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-3 dated 07.11.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible.
