It has been stated that FIR bearing No.234 dated 21.12.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC has been registered at Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala at the instance of petitioner No.1 against private respondents No. 7 to 11.

Grievance of the petitioners is to the effect that offences under Section 458 and 307 IPC have not been added and respondent No.5- Investigating Officer and respondent No.6 had instigated the accused to slip away from the spot after occurrence. It has also been stated that sufficient medical opinion has also not been procured.

It has further been stated that petitioner No.1 has already submitted a representation dated 25.12.2019 (Annexure P-5).

The petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – The Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievance of the petitioners, in accordance with law.
