By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the learned executing court to take necessary steps to conclude the proceedings before it, as have been initiated by the petitioner pursuant to a decree issued in his favour on November 21, 2018.

Mr. Walia, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that even though the said decree is slightly more than 1 year old and execution proceedings were initiated in 2019 only, as a matter of fact the litigation goes back to the year 1990, with the petitioner being 72 years old, and that he has had to file suits time and again essentially on the same cause of action.

Without making any comment on the merit of the case, but since the petitioner is shown to be 72 years old and it has been averred at least that he has been litigating since 1990, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the executing court to conclude the proceedings as early as possible.
