For the reasons mentioned in the application, duly supported by an affidavit of the applicant, same is allowed as prayed for. Documents Annexure P-6 and Annexure P-7 are taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Application is disposed of.

**CWP-1150-2020**

This petition has been filed seeking quashing of order dated 09.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), passed by the District Allotment Committee, Sangrur, whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be blacklisted for three years and a recommendation for cancellation of its license has also been made. Action was initiated and taken against the petitioner's lessee, M/s. Shivam Rice Mills. In the said proceedings, abovesaid order of blacklisting of the petitioner etc., was also passed.

The precise grievance of the petitioner-firm is that the authorities while taking action against the petitioner's lessee namely M/s. Shivam Rice Mills, could not have passed such an order with severe consequences, qua the petitioner-firm, without even a notice of the proceedings being served upon the petitioner-firm at any stage. It is further submitted that for the shortcoming or default, if any of M/s. Shivam Rice Mills, the petitioner could not have been proceeded against and that too in this manner.

During the pendency of this writ petition, the concerned District Allotment Committee, Sangrur has withdrawn order 09.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) to the extent of blacklisting of the petitioner-firm as well as the recommendation for cancellation of its license. A photocopy of order dated 28.01.2020 in this respect has been furnished in Court today.

Learned counsel for the State submits that notice has since been issued on 31.01.2020 to the petitioner, to show cause as to why appropriate action be not taken in terms of provisions of law.

Orders dated 28.01.2020 and 31.01.2020 are taken on record, subject to just exceptions as Mark-A and Mark-B.

In this view of the matter, present writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/file reply etc. in respect to notice dated 31.01.2020, in accordance with law.
