Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.143 dated 26.06.2017 registered under Sections 397,392,109,34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his argument to the extent that he would be satisfied if the direction is issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel points out that out of 26 witnesses, 13 have been examined and 8 have been given up, meaning thereby, only 5 witnesses remain to be examined. It is further pointed out that out of seven other criminal cases, the petitioner stands acquitted in three of them.

Since, five witnesses remain to be examined and the FIR is dated 26.06.2017, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the trial Court to take effective steps to conclude the trial expeditiously.
