For the reasons mentioned in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, the delay of 334 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

LPA No.80 of 2020 (O&M)

This appeal has been filed by the petitioner-appellant against the order dated 14.01.2019 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the petition being CWP-29179-2018 seeking direction to the State of Punjab to get an inquiry conducted into the conduct of respondent No.7, who is working as Assistant Sub Inspector in the Punjab Police.

Learned Single Judge after taking into consideration the facts noted that respondent No.7 has filed civil suit against the petitioner-appellant and all the possible defences and issues can be taken by the petitioner-appellant in the civil proceedings, including the defence regarding obtaining

loan on the basis of concocted documents. The learned Single Judge accordingly disposed of the petition giving liberty to petitioner to take up all possible issues in the civil proceedings, in accordance with law.

Having heard learned counsel for the appellant and having perused the order of the learned Single Judge, we do not find any perversity or illegality in the impugned order.

Reiterating the decision taken by learned Single Judge, the appeal being meritless is dismissed.
