Affidavit of Manoj Yadava, Director General of Police,
Haryana, Panchkula has been placed on record. In para No.7 of the reply, it
has been mentioned as following:-

*“That it is submitted that the averments made in the petition convey that three more FIRs in this case have been registered in Sarita Vihar Police Station, New Delhi and Madir Marg Police Station, New Delhi. Further, there are allegations of misappropriation of crores of rupees. Considering large number of victims and huge financial involvement, it has been decided to transfer the case FIR No.331 dated 22.06.2016 u/s 420/120B IPC Police Station Manesar, Gurugram to State Crime Branch, Haryana for further investigation to be conducted by a Special Investigation Team headed by an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police after due information to Ld. Trial Court. A copy of the letter dated 12.02.2020 is annexed as **Annexure R-1** for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”*

Since, Special Investigation Team has already been instituted,
no further action is called for in the present case at this stage.
